1 - \$2,500.00 1 year scholarship for Eddyville students only.

#### **Application:**

1. Eddyville standard application
2. A brief narrative of how pursuing a career in the Forest Industry or Natural Resources will benefit you and how you will use the funds if awarded.

#### **Criteria:**

1. Senior planning to attend a four year college pursuing a career in the Forest Industry or Natural Resources

#### **Restrictions:**

1. Funds must be used for tuition, books and equipment to enhance the career field of Forestry or Natural Resources.
2. Scholarship will be awarded upon successful completion (passing grades) of the first semester of enrollment.

### **Ronny + Rene Visual Arts Scholarship**

1-2 at \$500 each for Eddyville students only.

#### **Application:**

1. Eddyville standard application
2. A brief narrative of how pursuing a creative passion personally benefits you and how you will use the funds if awarded.

#### **Criteria:**

1. Senior in the Photography/Visual Arts CTE program that shows an interest in pursuing any visual/audio art as a career or creative outlet post secondary.

#### **Restrictions:**

1. Must use funds for arts school, arts education, equipment or any other opportunity to further grow your passion.

### **Love Can Build a Bridge Scholarship**

1 @ \$1000 for a graduating senior from Eddyville Charter School.

*This scholarship will be granted to the student who best demonstrates kindness, compassion and/or generosity to others within the past eighteen months. Applicants are asked to submit a handwritten essay providing evidence for their acts and describing multiple examples if applicable. Relate your past acts of kindness, compassion and generosity to your short and long-range goals for the future. Thank you for applying and making the world a better place.*

#### **Application:**

#### **Criteria:**

1. Interest in pursuing a career that helps people
2. Desire to make the world a better place

#### **Restrictions:**

1. Must be used for career training costs which may include: tuition, travel, books, room and board, trainings, seminars

### **Greg Palser Memorial Scholarship**

1 @ \$12,000 for a graduating senior from Eddyville Charter School.

#### **Application:**

1. Eddyville standard application
2. After reviewing the application, there will be an additional interview process with the selection committee.

#### **Criteria:**

1. A senior pursuing either telecommunications or electrical lineworker certification from Northwest Lineman College in Meridian, Idaho. Preference will be given to telecommunications.

#### **Restrictions:**

1. Scholarship will be awarded upon acceptance and registration into Northwest Lineman College.
2. Upon completion of graduation of the program, a letter of review to the donors about the program and their experience. Additionally, the recipient must be a guest speaker to a class at Eddyville to explain their career & promote the scholarship for future recipients.

### **The Endless Grind Scholarship**

1-2 at \$250 each for Eddyville students only

#### **Application:**

1. Eddyville standard application
2. A short essay detailing how CTE classes at Eddyville have positively impacted your education or personal life. (300 words max)

#### **Criteria:**

1. ECS seniors who have done a CTE class for 2 full years or more may apply. CTE classes at Eddyville include: cooking, sewing, business, woodshop, welding, framing, construction, small engines, horticulture, photography, and sports media.

#### **Restrictions:**

1. Must be put towards career training costs which may include: tuition, travel, books, room and board, training, and seminars.

### **Eddyville Boosters**

1 @ \$500 for Eddyville senior.

#### **Application:**

1. Eddyville standard application
2. A brief narrative of how applicant has provided community service to their local community, and how applicant will use scholarship to pursue other community service projects to benefit others.

#### **Criteria:**

1. Senior planning to pursue community service opportunities.
2. Applicants must have documentation of community services provided and have signatures of when those services were rendered.

#### **Restrictions**

1. Funds must be used for equipment and supplies to enhance the community service project.
2. Scholarship will be awarded upon successful completion of the community service project.
