Dear ECS Community,

Happy New Year and we hope this letter finds you all in good health. With the latest developments in the world of COVID and rapid spread of Omicron, many updates and guidelines have developed that I would like to address in terms of impact on our Eddyville Charter School community.

The ECS Team will continue to implement layers of mitigation and safeguards necessary to keep our doors open for in-person learning and athletic activities. We have also created more separation at the secondary level during lunch to enhance social distance safety measures. In our mission to keep in-person learning available, we want to take this opportunity to ask for your cooperation.

Please,

- ✓ Encourage your student(s) to wear masks, socially distance, sanitize and wash hands frequently and stay home when experiencing COVID or cold and flu symptoms. If you have questions about these symptoms, you can find many resources on our website: www.eddyvillecharterschool.org/health-center.html
- ✓ Wear your mask, socially distance and sanitize while on campus and during athletic events and stay home if you are experiencing COVID or cold/flu symptoms.
- ✓ Contact Betsy Brooks, school nurse, for information on vaccinations and booster options as needed. Below is Betsy's summary of current guidance as of 1/12/2022:
 - Isolation for COVID-19 positive: individuals are to isolate for 5 days, and may return to activities if symptoms have lessened. They must continue to wear a mask at school, and are encouraged to wear a mask when not at school for an additional 5 days.
 - Quarantine for outside of the home exposure (if exposure occurred at school, see the test to stay program below): individuals are to quarantine for 5 days, and may return to activities as long they have not had symptoms or tested positive. They must continue to wear a mask at school, and are encouraged to wear a mask when not at school for an additional 5 days.
 - Quarantine for home/community living space exposure: individuals are to quarantine for 10 days, and may return to activities as long as they have not had any symptoms or tested positive. They must continue to wear a mask at school, and are encouraged to wear a mask when not at school for an additional 5 days.

ECS is also working hard to keep our athletic programs operating! As a league, we are working to serve our communities and we ask that you are patient and flexible as schedules and protocols are ever-changing. We will continue to send out information as updates are available in terms of schedules, game broadcasts and allowance



- ✓ Eddyville is currently allowing fans from both teams to attend as long as they wear masks and follow safety protocols.
- ✓ Limited concessions will be available (pre-packaged items only)
- ✓ NFHS broadcast of games will also be available for our home games. Away contests will either be streamed through NFHS or via You Tube link sent to our AD by the opposing team's AD. Links will be on FB and on our Athletics page on the school website.
