Board Members,

Attached you will also find the 2023-24 financial statement through September 30, 2023. These statements include the General Fund Statement of Revenues Budget vs. Actual, General Fund Statement of Expenditures Budget vs. Actual, Special Revenue Funds Revenue and Expenditures, and total Appropriations for the year.

The General Fund statements include the actual revenues and expenditures from July 1, 2023 through September, 2023. The projections are based on budget at this point until the September payroll is processed and salary lines encumbered. The estimated General Fund Ending Fund Balance is \$250,000. Contingency makes up \$100,000 of the Fund Balance total.

The final audit for FY22-23 is scheduled for the week of August 15, 2023 and has now been completed and fund balances have been rolled forward

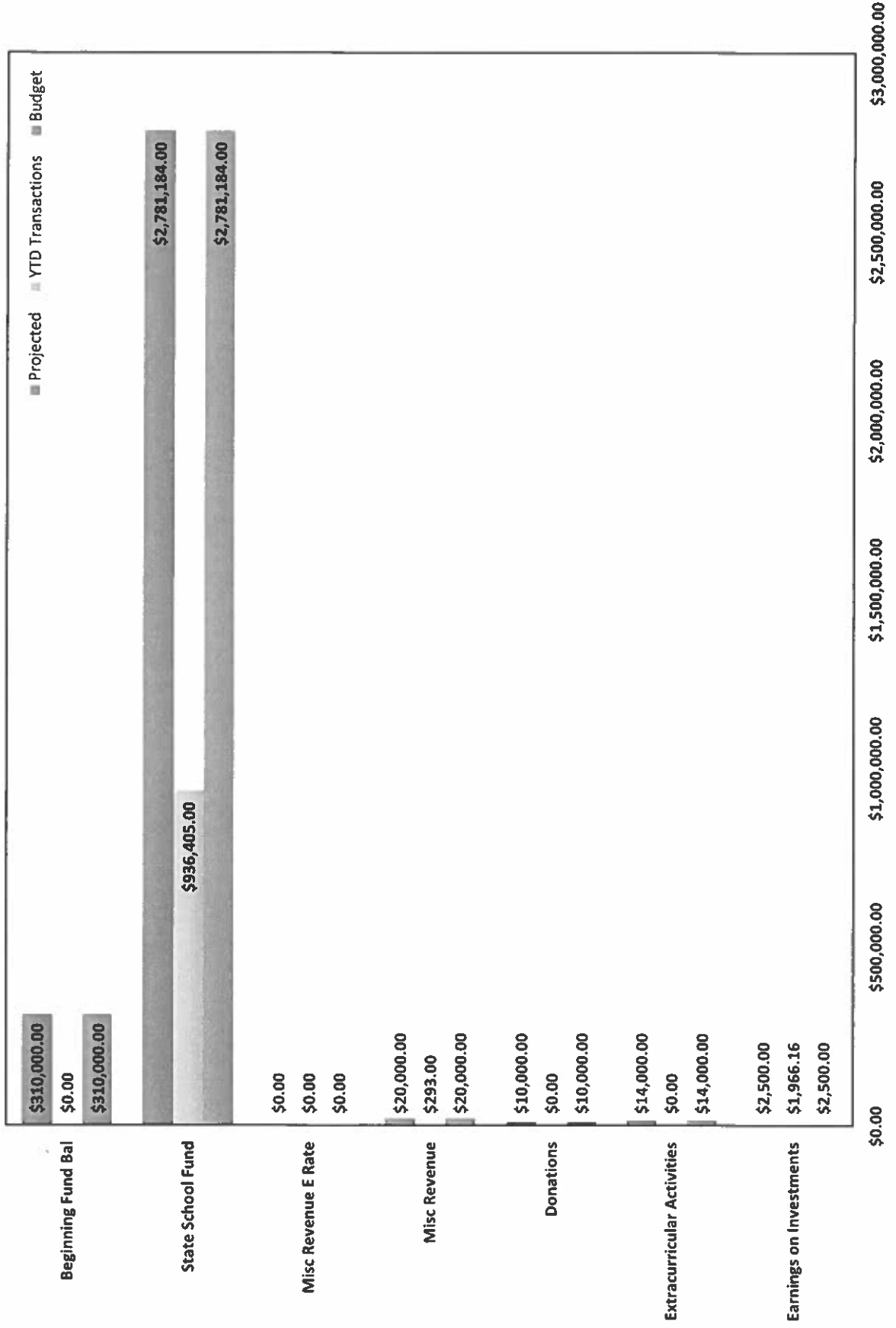
Eddyville Charter School investments are held in an interest-bearing money market account. Investments total \$868,087.55 and are yielding an interest rate of .5%. Dividend payments July 1, 2023 – September 30, 2023 total \$1,966.16.

# General Fund Revenue - September 2023 Projections - YTD - Budget

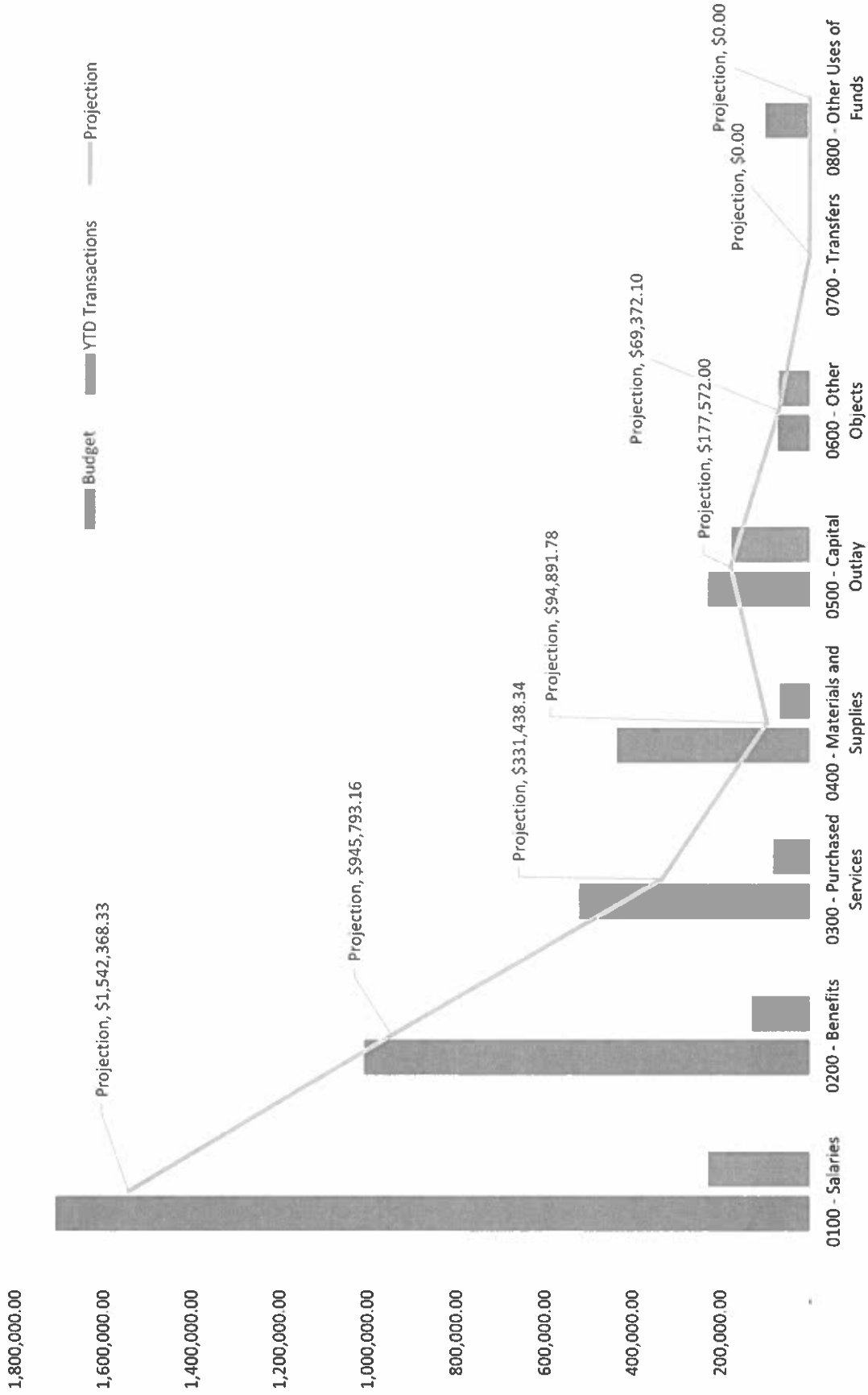

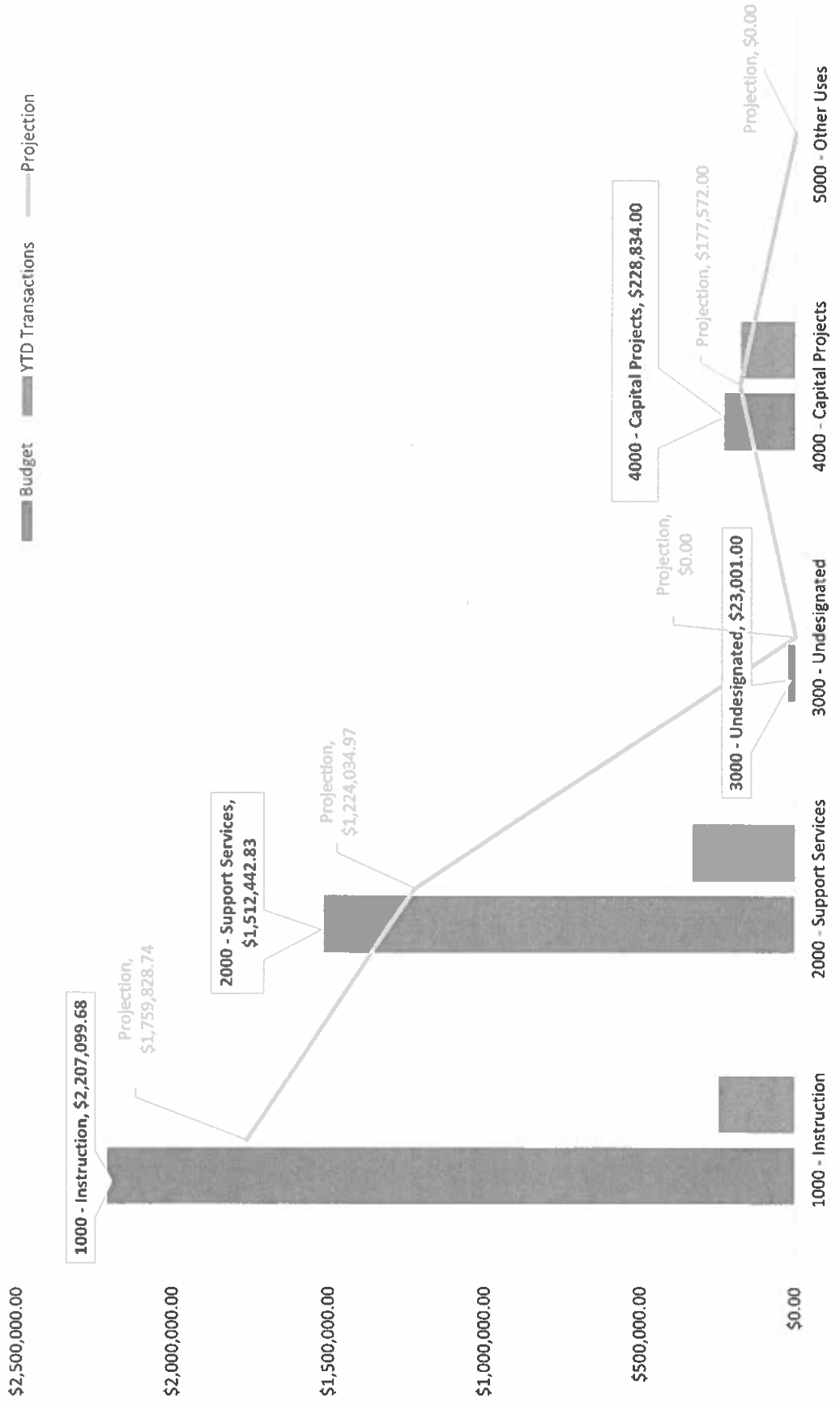
# EXPENDITURES BY OBJECT

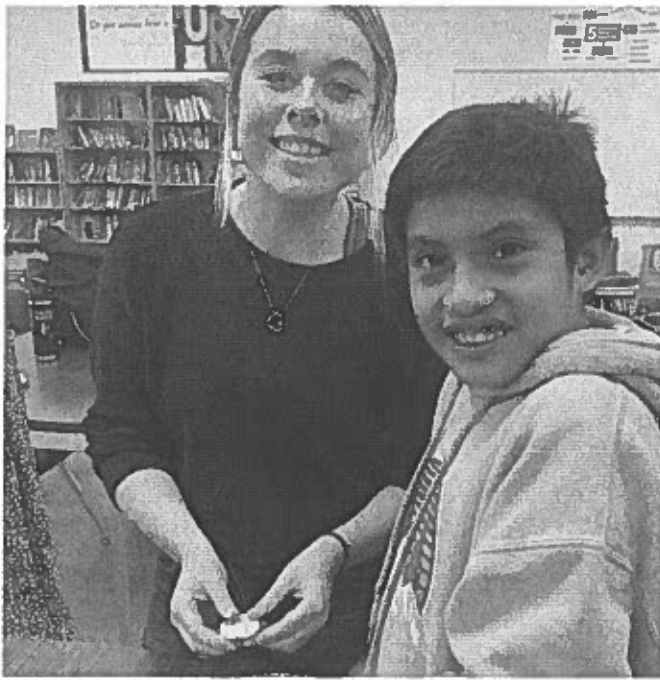

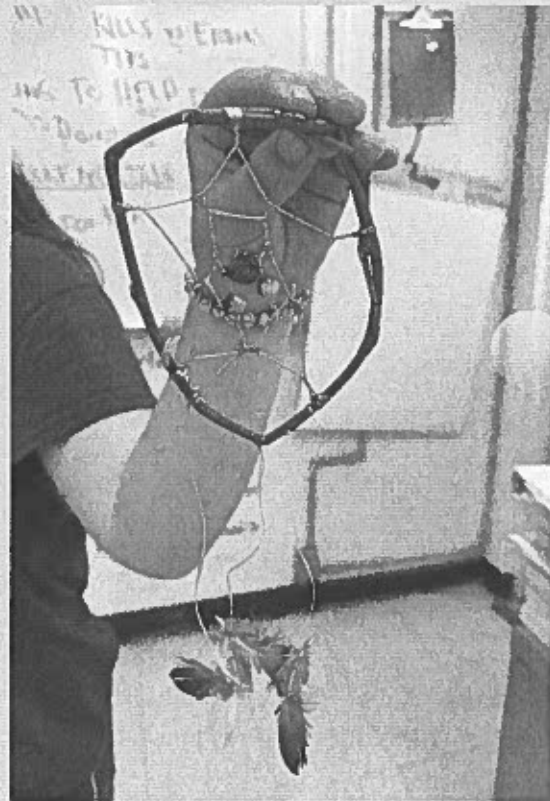
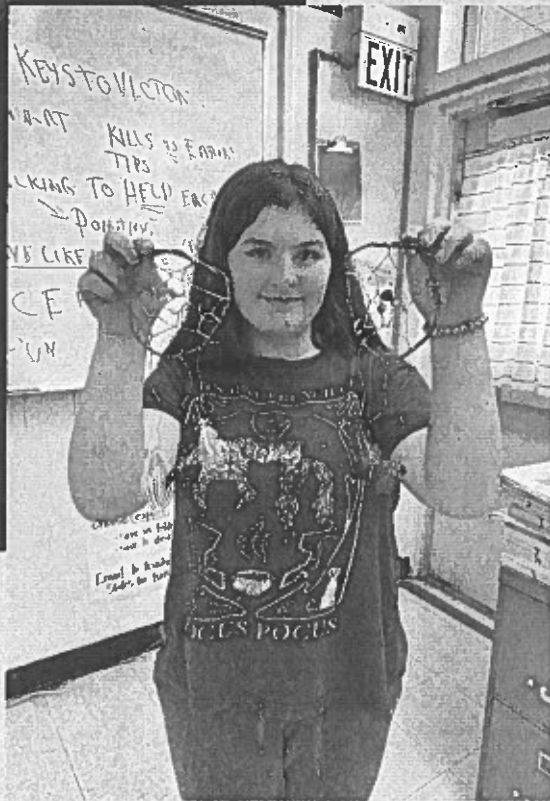

# Proposed Maxims Options

Eddyville Charter School • August 2023

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In 2023, leaders from Eddyville Charter School gathered feedback from students, staff, and families in order to better capture the priorities, values, and beliefs of the community. Stakeholders included **29** students, **17** staff, and **14** family and community members. Feedback was collected through in-person listening sessions as well as an online survey. Inflexion staff analyzed the feedback to identify trends and synthesize commonalities across the stakeholder groups.

Stakeholders were asked to

- describe an ideal school;
- describe the characteristics, skills, mindsets, and behaviors students need in order to prepare for their futures; and
- identify the unique personality of the school community and the traits most valued in the community by creatively imagining their school as an animal and describing how it represents the school.

These questions help us discover what is most important to the community when it comes to student readiness. This report highlights the ideas and themes that emerged.

They described a student that is ready for life after graduation as someone with the following characteristics, behaviors, and mindsets.



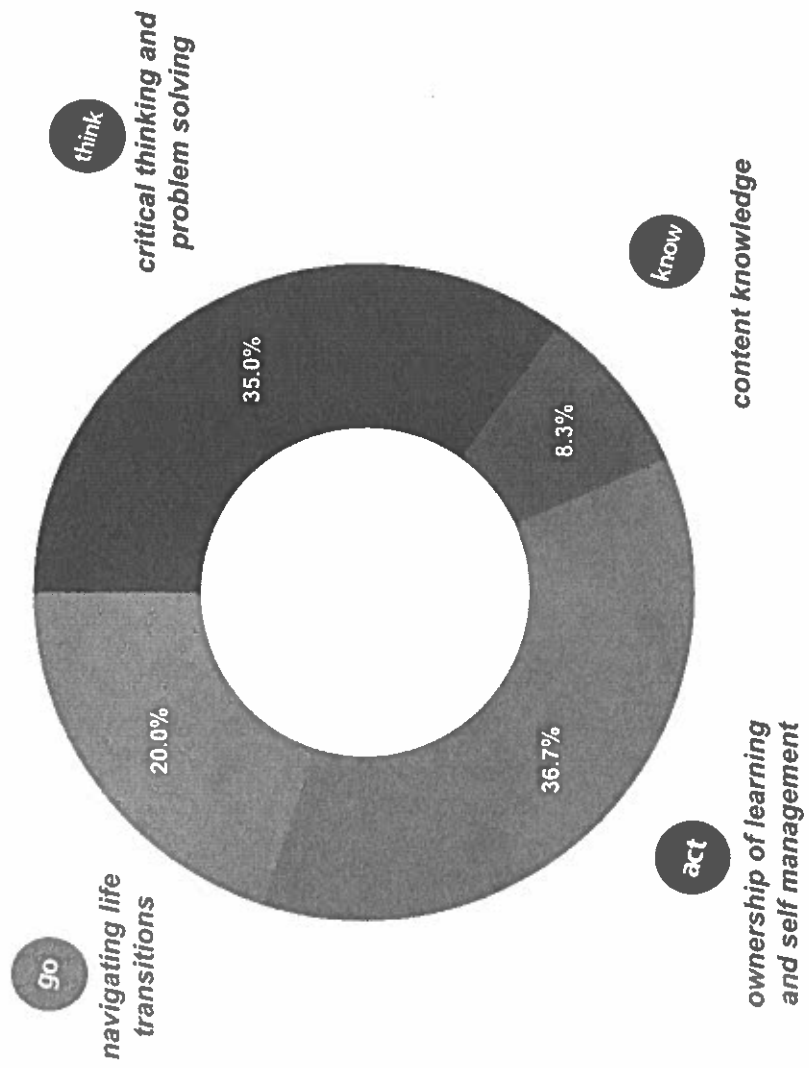

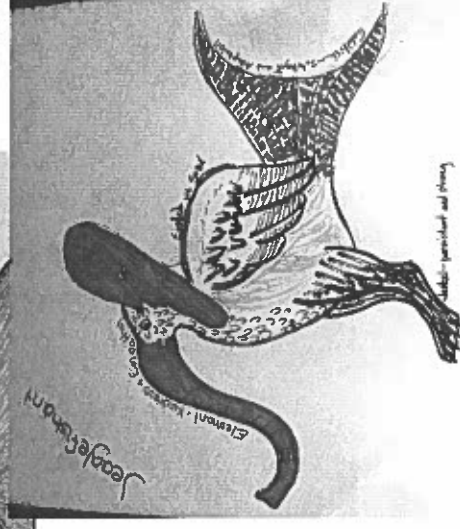
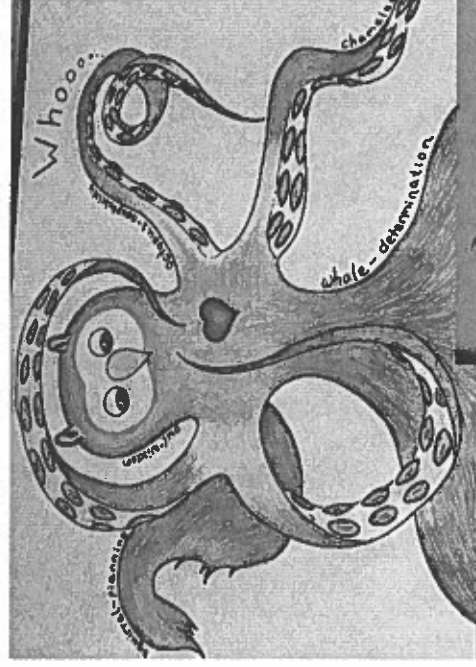
### What are the Four Keys to College and Career Readiness?

The **Four Keys** is a research-based framework that describes a holistic approach to student readiness. In its simplest form, we refer to the Four Keys as **Think, Know, Act, and Go**.

In other words, students ready to be lifelong learners have the ability to **THINK** deeply about what they are doing; **KNOW** contextually why they learn; **ACT** purposefully to achieve their goals; and **GO** successfully through life's transitions.



Stakeholders identified the animals that best embody the characteristics and personality of the school. Across the many animals described, a few personality traits rose to the top as best embodying the school community. These include being **kind, proud, loving, strong, protective, caring, happy, friendly, mindful, and loyal.**

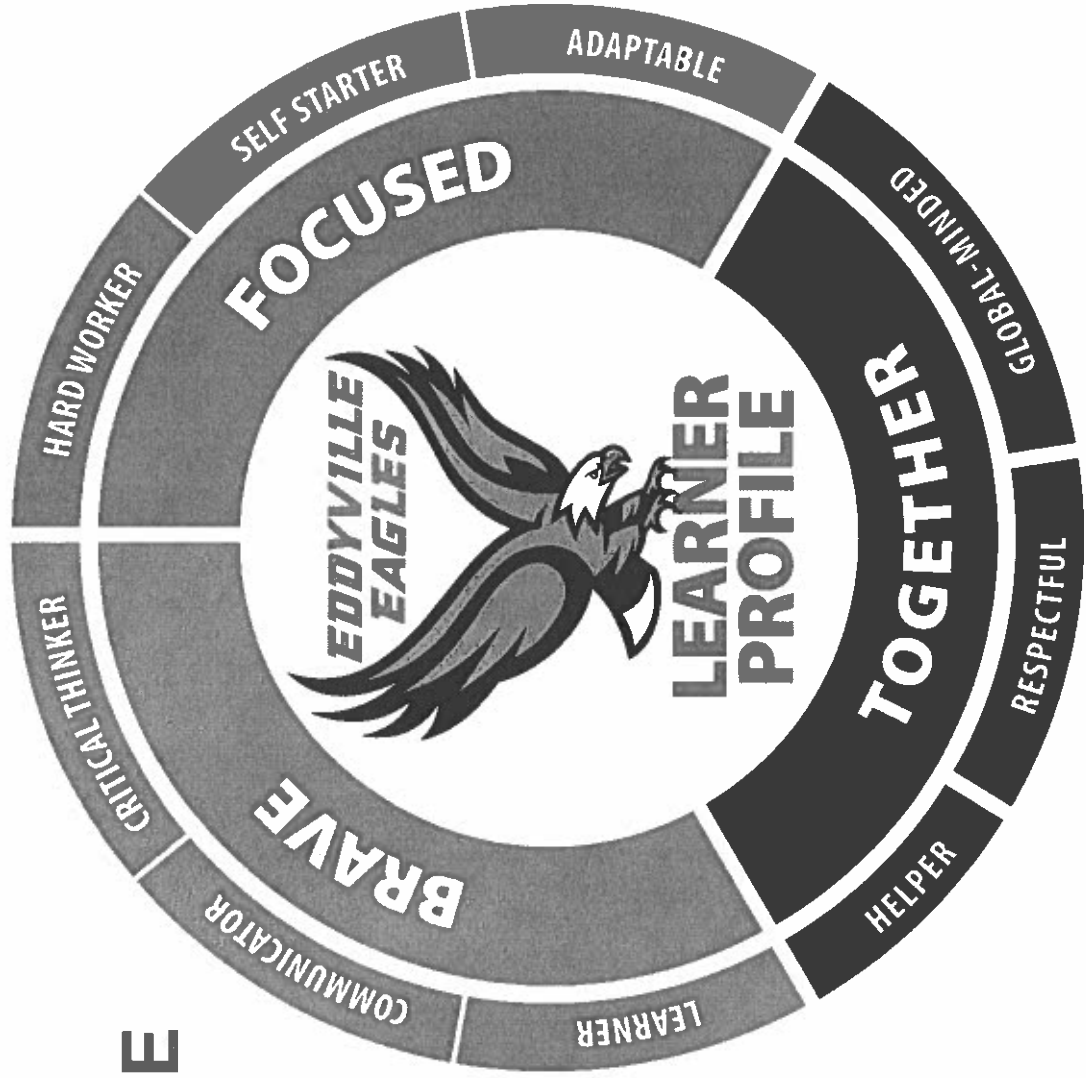

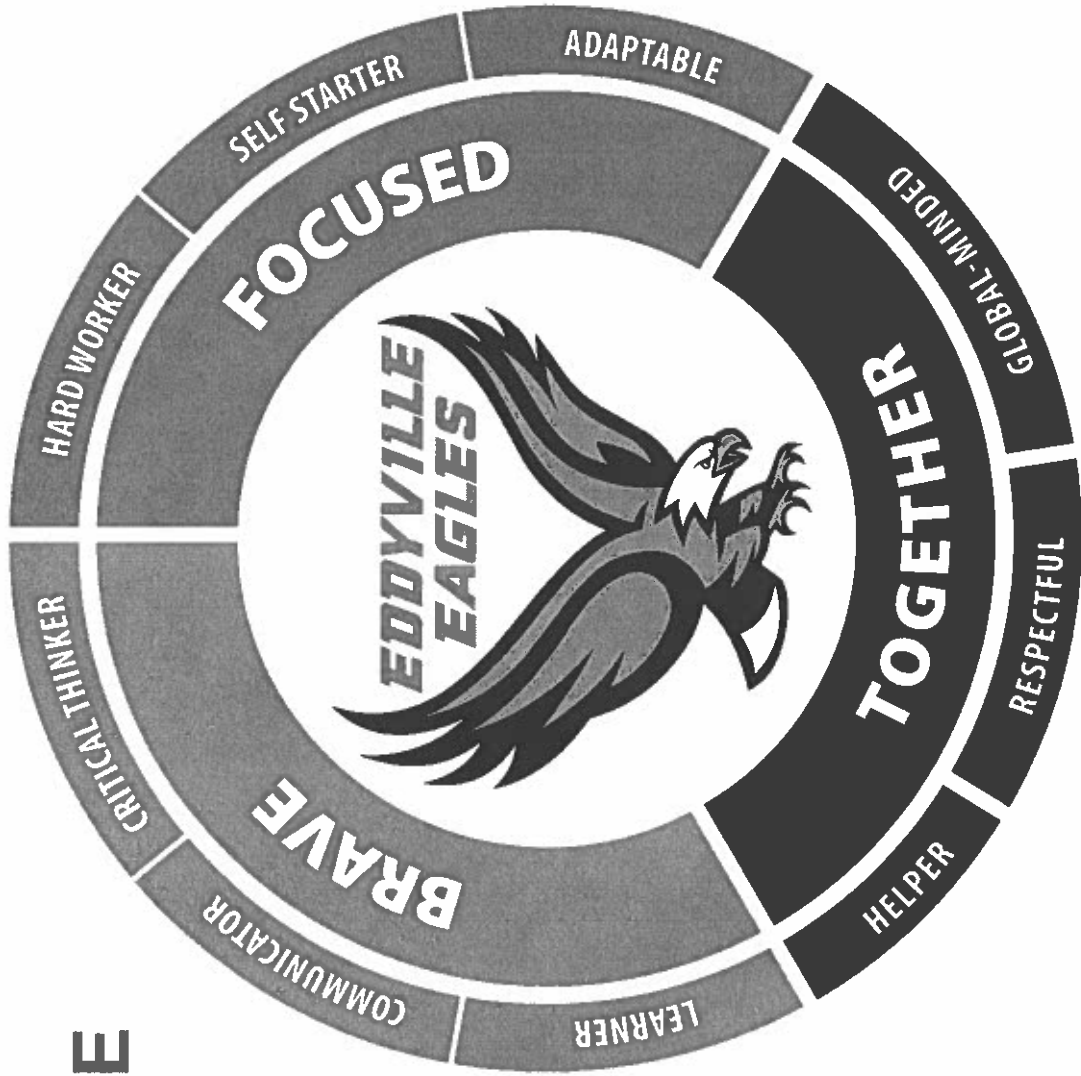
